



West Nairobi High School Four Year Plan

Procedures

1. Be aware of the graduation requirements.
2. Freshmen and new students should develop a Four-Year Plan.
3. Read the course descriptions and check the prerequisites carefully.
4. Select classes to fill seven periods per day.
5. In classes where enrollment is limited, preference will be given to upperclassmen.
6. If there is insufficient demand for certain courses, they may not be taught. In these cases students will choose another course.

24 credits are required for a College Preparatory Diploma. Each semester represents one-half credit satisfactorily completed.
